C-SEB Early Ideas Workshop // Lisa Spantig (RWTH Aachen) Effects of Fraud on Digital Services Use (with Laura Nelima Barasa, Elif Kubilay and Eva Raiber)

Digital services have become increasingly widespread in education, health, the financial sector, and the labor market. They can benefit consumers by increasing service access and improving efficiency, especially in developing countries. However, these benefits come with growing concerns about consumer protection, particularly regarding fraud. We study the causal effect of fraud on consumer behavior in the context of digital services. Specifically, we investigate how perceptions of fraud affect trust and service usage. Perceptions of fraud might impact consumers either through the fear of being contacted, or, conditional on being contacted, through the fear of falling for fraud. We propose an experimental design in which we exogenously vary beliefs about fraud prevalence and scam detection ability to evaluate impacts on trust in and use of digital services.
